SERIES HISTORY

The Deborah Heart and Lung Center Jersey Jam is the first meeting between Rutgers and Princeton in 10 years! The last matchup was on December 11, 2013 in Piscataway where the Tigers triumphed over the Scarlet Knights 78-73. Princeton leads the all-time series 75-45.

ON THIS SAME DATE ..

What is considered to be the first American football game was played 154 years ago on the same date as the Deborah Heart and Lung Center Jersey Jam - November 6, 1869, between Rutgers and Princeton. The teams consisted of 25 players each and used a round ball that could not be picked up or carried. The ball could be kicked or batted with the feet, hands, head, or sides. Rutgers won the game 6–4.

DEEPEST NCAA TOURNAMENT RUNS

Rutgers: Final Four 1976

The Scarlett Knights reached the 1976 final four with a perfect record of 30-0. Rutgers defeated Princeton in the first round of the tournament.

Princeton: Final Four 1965

The Tigers advanced to the national semifinal in 1965 where they fell to Michigan. Princeton would win the third-place game over Wichita State.

THE WILDEST GAME OF THE MATCHUP

In a year which would end in a final four appearance for Rutgers, the undefeated Scarlett Knights clashed with Princeton in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. With Princeton trailing 54-53 in the final seconds, 90% free throw shooter Peter Malloy was fouled with a chance to win the game. Rutgers coach Tom Young called two consecutive timeouts to ice the shooter. Malloy missed the front end of the oneand-one and Rutgers held on for the victory.
